Yearbook Staff: How do you feel the 1984-85 school year went compared to last year's?

There is presently being developed a partnership arranged with a private organization, which would provide we hope, up to sixty jobs for qualified students in the 11th and 12th grades next year. These jobs are designed so as to be a permanent type, consequently, special classes and on-the-job training programs will be designed to enhance student success. Most importantly, I feel the best fact is that students will be able to see a direct relationship between class work and the world of work.

Yearbook Staff: Do you have any comments about the Class of '85'?

Mr. Brown: The Senior Class of 1985 has many outstanding individuals. By comparison with other district schools, the eight students presently enrolled in the UMKC Math/Science programs have made outstanding progress in this college credited program. Many within the class, have made outstanding progress both academically and athletically. There appears to be an unusually large number of seniors who are goal oriented and are working toward their goal, whether it is college, military, or entry into the work force.

By comparison, only after the June 3, commencement exercises will I be able to say for sure what I feel the maturity level is of the class, based on how well the ceremony goes.
